RESOLUTION OF

THE TRENTON PARKING AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH KEJ ASSOCIATES, LLC FOR INTERIM EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Trenton Parking Authority ("Authority") is a public corporation established by declaration of necessity by the legislature in the Parking Authorities Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:11A-1 <u>et seq.</u>; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is vested with all powers necessary or convenient to carry out and effectuate its corporate purpose of the construction, provision or operation of off-street parking projects within its area of operation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Parking Authorities Act, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:11A-5, the commissioners "may employ a secretary, technical experts and such other officers, agents and employees, permanent and temporary, as it may require, and shall determine their qualifications, duties and compensation"; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution R2020-1:01, the Authority engaged KEJ Associates, LLC for the services of Interim Executive Director for the period February 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has resolved to engage in a "fair and open" process to find a firm to continue provide the Authority with Interim Executive Director Services for a term of one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, the Authority did solicit qualifications for Interim Executive Director Services by RFQ; and

WHEREAS, the Parking Authority received one response; and

WHEREAS, the response received was evaluated by an Evaluation Committee and the proposal of KEJ Associates, LLC was deemed qualified and advantageous to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Agreement will be for one (1) year beginning on April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Trenton Parking Authority, as follows:

- 1. The Commissioners of the Trenton Parking Authority authorize a contract with KEJ Associates, LLC, 32 Jackie Drive, Lawrenceville, New Jersey 08648, which shall remain on file in the Authority's office and available for public inspection.
- 2. The contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00 and for a term of no more than twelve (12) months.
- 4. A notice of this action shall be printed in the Legal Newspaper of the Authority as required by law within ten (10) days of its passage.
- 5. The vendor shall supply the Authority with the Federal Affirmative Action Plan Approval or State Certificate of Employee Information Report within the time period specified by N.J.A.C. 17:27. The contract shall contain the mandatory affirmative language for professional services contracts required by N.J.A.C. 17:27, a copy of which shall be attached to and incorporated in the services contract authorized herein.
- 6. The vendor shall agree to comply with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and indemnify, protect and save harmless the Authority from all suits, claims, losses, demands or damages of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of alleged violations of the Act. A copy of the Act shall be attached to and incorporated in the services agreement authorized herein.
